It was 61 years ago, during the winter of 1963-1964, when a small group of women led by Burney L. Harris started holding meetings at different homes in Green Pond for the purpose of "bringing together the winter residents of Green Pond and Lake End Corporation, plus its Associate Members, for establishing a better community and environs, to provide entertainment and education through its programs and committees, and to adopt certain welfare and charity programs."

And so the Green Pond Winter Woman's Club was born, nurtured at first by a handful of dedicated women. Time moved on and life-styles changed. The word "Winter" was removed from our Club's name as we became a year-round entity. Here we are many years later, celebrating our Club's 61st year. What have we accomplished just during the past Club year to help our community and bring together our members and their children?

Let's look back:

- Scholarships: In May 2024 we awarded scholarships totaling \$10,000 to three Green Pond graduating students.
- Green Pond Charities Fund: Our Club was able to make many charitable donations during the year, thanks to the generosity of our Club Members and your support of our fundraising efforts. In 2024 we made charitable donations amounting to \$9,000, including the following organizations:

- Christmas Greetings Project for December 2024:
 Resulted in donations totaling \$2,800 which were equally divided between the Green Pond First Aid Squad and the Green Pond Volunteer Fire Department.
- Annual Membership Tea: All Green Pond women are invited to the Club's Annual Summer Membership Tea on July 16 for an afternoon of fellowship, light fare, punch and desserts.
- Family Bingo Nights: Several Friday evenings during the summer months in the Community House, Bingo Games bring together children, parents and grandparents alike for some fun.
- Children's Parties: Many Green Pond children enjoy our Children's Halloween Party and record-breaking Easter Egg Hunt consisting of over 4,000 eggs.
- Holiday Activities: We are busy at the holidays with all sorts of activities – donating groceries to food banks, awarding special gifts to the winners of the Annual House Decorating Contest, winning one of the Garden Club's evergreen baskets and enjoying a special holiday program at our December General Meeting..
- Sunshine & Outreach Committees: Throughout the year, our Sunshine & Outreach Chairpersons and various members of our community look for opportunities to reach out and help our fellow Green Ponders by sending cards and delivering many homemade meals.
- Knitting/Crocheting Group: A group of Green Pond women who
 enjoy knitting get together and make children's sweaters and blankets
 for World Vision, a Christian organization that sends these sweaters
 and blankets to wherever they are needed around the world.
- * Club Newsletter: GPWC Lakeviews & News is published throughout the year as a means of keeping Club members apprised of both Club and community events in Green Pond. And when there is "breaking" news, we will send updates via email.
- Garden Club: Our Garden Club beautifies various areas around Green Pond with their annual planting and maintenance of flowers.

When you multiply all of the above accomplishments by 61 years, you can see that our Club has played an important role as our special community of Green Pond has grown over the years.
